Go into your phone settings and select **Wi-Fi**. Ensure Wi-Fi option is switched on. Tap on **MDXOPEN**.

Once connection has been established, you will be shown a Cookies option before you can proceed to connecting to **MDXOPEN**, Read the information and press **"OK**"

Once accepted, you will be directed to a webpage to enable the internet connection to access MDXOPEN. Select "Start using MDXOPEN"

The Wi-Fi icon will be visible on the top left corner on your phone. You can also check the Wi-Fi settings, MDXOPEN will show a blue tick confirming a successful connection.
